**CMLTI (Colegio Mexicano de Licenciados en Traducción e Interpretación)** is pleased to invite professional translators, interpreters, trainers, researchers, and other linguistic mediation professionals to submit their abstracts and join us for the 4<sup>th</sup> Edition of the International Virtual Congress “Translation Week,” which will focus on *Society, Linguistic Mediation, and Modernity*.

Since its first edition, the Translation Week has aimed to provide a space for analysis and reflection where national and international translation and interpretation professionals can share their research, experiences, and knowledge. Additionally, it serves as a forum to address current issues that impact the professional practice of translators and interpreters.

This year, the Translation Week will take place from September 2 to 6, 2024, across digital platforms, to reach a wider audience and promote the democratization of knowledge.

Abstracts on the following thematic areas will be accepted:



Specialized translation and interpreting, literary translation, audiovisual translation, localization, transcreation, post-editing, proofreading, editing, translation and interpreting technologies, forensic linguistics and translation, terminology, lexicography, sign language interpreting, translation and interpretation of indigenous languages, RSI, and professional ethics.

The following formats will be available to participants:

- **Presentations** (a 40- to 60-minute presentation and 15 minutes for Q&A)
- **Panel discussions of up to four participants** (with a 15-minute presentation per speaker and 15 minutes for the Q&A section)

### **General Criteria for Abstract Submission**

Abstracts should be between 300 and 500 words long and include the presentation title, keywords, thematic area, the speaker's or panelists' full name, and their academic background.

All abstracts must be submitted in PDF format to [vinculacion@cmlti.mx](mailto:vinculacion@cmlti.mx) and [presidencia@cmlti.mx](mailto:presidencia@cmlti.mx).

The deadline for abstract submission is **July 15, 2024**.

All abstracts will be reviewed and approved by the Scientific/Organizing Committee, and the results of the selection will be announced in August.
